


PCSB User

PCSB Users can view Next Generation Assessments scores for all LEAs under their purview.


1. Log into SLED with your username and password.




2. Accept the **SLED User Access Agreement**.




- From the Current Enrollment Public Charter School LEA Summary (uncertified) display select **Next Generation Assessments Roster Summary** under the **Programs** menu.

About This Assessment
Scott took the PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) in English Language Arts & Literacy in Spring 2015. This test was given for the first time in 2015 and is different from the DC CAS. PARCC asks students to answer more challenging and real-world questions that measure the knowledge and skills needed for success in their grade, and ultimately in college and careers.

How Does Scott's Performance Compare to Past Performance?
The last ELA test that Scott took was the Grade 4 DC CAS. This report does not make a direct comparison between the PARCC and DC CAS because they are very different tests. First, the scoring and performance levels are different. Second, the PARCC is considered more challenging because of the real-world questions that measure the knowledge and skills students need to succeed in their grade, and ultimately in college and careers.

On his year's PARCC, Scott scored better than **42%** of DC 5th graders.

On the Grade 4 DC CAS, Scott scored better than **37%** of DC 4th graders.

How Does Scott's Score Compare to Other 5th Grade Students?
Compared to other 5th Grade students tested on this year's PARCC, Scott scored better than this percentage of students:

- Scott's School: **35%**
- DCPS: **40%**
- DC: **42%**

How Does Scott Compare to Students at the Same School?


